


After completing the courses, you may go on to graduate school or professional programs in nursing studies, clinical nursing, long-term care and nursing administration.

The Program Features

During the two-week online study, you will attend classes for six to seven hours a day and participate in in-class and group project discussions with different professors and international students. A group of professors from several countries will share their different nursing philosophy to let you know each nation's health management systems. The topics of this program are very diverse and international. If you make enough efforts in this program, you will make a difference to your future life.
